## Looking for Slope in Real Life ...

- You need to find 16 examples of slope in real life. Find the examples based on a central theme. For example, 16 pictures of your trip to Yellowstone, 16 pictures of baseball items, etc. You can use pictures you take, Clip Art, or images from the internet.
- Identify at least:
- 4 Positive Slopes
- 4 Negative Slopes
- 4 Zero Slopes
- 4 Undefined Slopes
- 1 of the 16 must include parallel lines
- 1 of the 16 must include perpendicular lines
*** Make sure you are only identifying straight lines - no curves! ***
- Create an electronic slide/page-based presentation (ex: powerpoint, prezi, storyjumper, etc.)
- Cover page ( $1^{\text {st }}$ slide) that includes your first name and last initial, teacher's name, and class period.
- One picture per slide/page.
- Draw a line (with arrows) on each slope.
- Create a text box that identifies the type of slope.
- Save your file as firstlastnameclassperiod (example: johndoe5.ppt)
- You must save your file, and then drop it in the homework dropbox in Gaggle. Do NOT wait until the last minute! If your presentation is saved as a link, e-mail the link to your teacher.
